School drop-off



Best attending class so far: OAK (30C): 100%


Brizlincote East Side Arts Event

Our children came back last week to find their cloakrooms had dramatically changed and every child now has a locker in school close to their classroom.


This helps them to organise their belongings and will hopefully mean things won't get lost.


