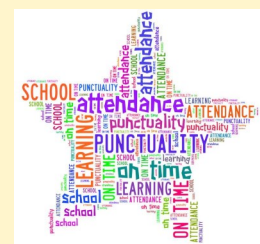
Reading at Edge Hill

Year 3 completing some work on measurement. Some excellent maths work from them this morning!

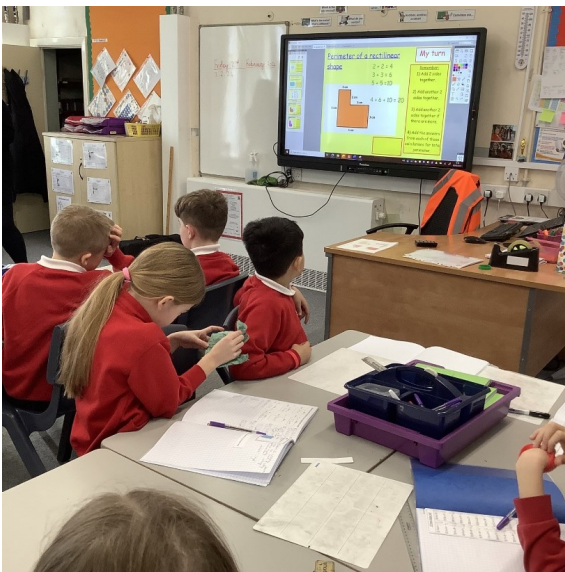


By the end of year 3, children should be able to measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm).
