Autumn Term Curriculum

Dear Parents

Please find attached information outlining the curriculum your child will be covering this term.

During year 5, your child will be exposed to daily reading, writing and maths lessons. Reading can be supported at home by encouraging regular independent reading. Reading for pleasure at home and in school will motivate and engage children with their learning and allow them to achieve their very best and personally develop as an individual. It is helpful to discuss the texts that your child is reading and when they have finished a book, talk to your child about whether they enjoyed reading the book, referring to parts of the story they enjoyed or did not enjoy.

Children will have tasks to complete at home which will include spelling and Maths homework in the form of TT Rockstars (3 x 15 minutes weekly). There will also be two pieces of optional extended project homework during the year.

Please find the time to encourage and support your child with their homework as this will help them a great deal within school.

Children will continue to have their Home School Link Books. These are a vital link between home and school and will help the children make the best of their time at school.

Our PE lessons this term will be on a Wednesday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor) afternoon. Please send your child to school wearing the appropriate PE kit for indoor or outdoor PE lessons on these days. Earrings should be removed for PE, if your child struggles with this please practice with them at home. If the piercings are new and earrings cannot be removed, then tape will need to be provided from home. Please note that the Meadowside will not allow children to swim with earrings in.

Your child will have 1 week of outdoor learning in the forest this term. On these days, please ensure your child is wearing weather appropriate clothing to school (dates shown below).
