Dear families, Thank you for such a positive start to our term together. The children have been absolutely amazing. We have to remember that this is the first school year where Covid has not been a constant topic for discussion. It is now time to ensure that routines are back in place to support our children in order to normalise their lives again.

In school, we have also made some slight changes to safeguard your children and keep them safe and cared for, as follows:

Site safety:

We want to assure you we are keeping your children safe at all times when in our care. We are ensuring cars can't access the driveway during entrance times and the gate is closed to ensure there is no danger of children leaving the site if left unattended. We thank you for arriving at 8:40am to drop your child into school before the 9:00am bell. When picking up, the new system has allowed children to be handed over safely to parents and also enabled staff to build relationships with you, which is very important to us. A big thanks to you all for understanding the need to keep your children as safe as possible.

Lunchtimes:

We have now moved lunchtime to 12pm to ensure the children have an earlier dinner. To support this, we now have 2 sittings: 12-12:30pm for year 3/4 and 12:30-1pm for year 5/6. This ensures there are less children on the playground at any one time.

We are now working with Rocket Music to build on the skills they learn at Violet Way. Super!
